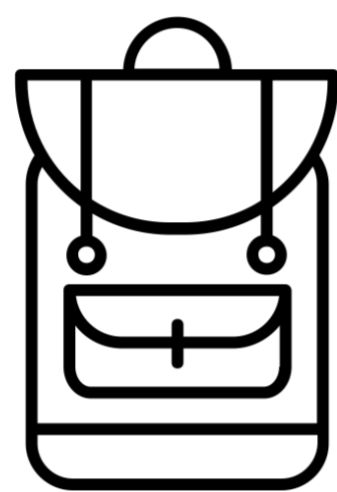
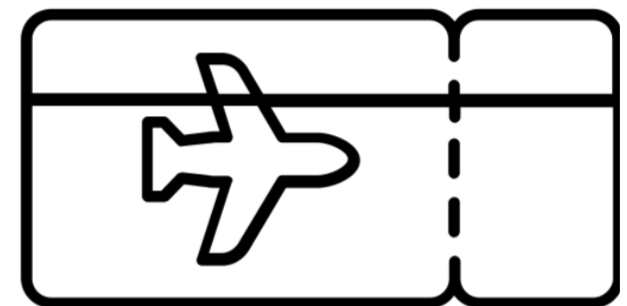

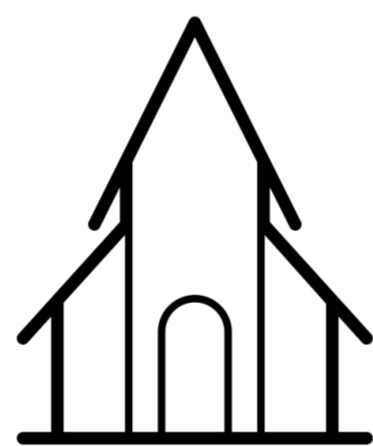
Taken a language in high school?

- Earn 4-16 credits toward graduation for the courses you place out of.

How to take the Placement Test:

French, German & Spanish

Step 1: Visit the testing center website, testing.boisestate.edu/ml/, to schedule your test.

Step 2: Bring your student ID and and payment receipt to your scheduled appointment. Please allow up to two hours to complete the test.

Step 3: Allow 24 hours for your score to be entered into the system. Register for the course.
