

Apps to Download: YouTube & YouTube Capture

As a way to easily view YouTube videos and to upload your own content, you'll want to download the YouTube and YouTube Capture app from the App Store (both free.)



Features:

- Enjoy “what to watch” recommendations
- Find videos and channels with voice search and instant search suggestions
- Subscribe to your favorite channels for easy access from the guide
- Sign-in to access your playlists and “watch later” list
- Share videos via Google+, E-mail, Facebook and Twitter

- Easy, fast recording
- Touch up videos with color correction, stabilization, trimming, and music tracks
- Upload to YouTube, Google+, Facebook, and Twitter simultaneously

Instructions to Download YouTube & YouTube Capture

Your iPad includes many Spanish Language tools including a dictionary and text-to-speech feature! Follow the instructions below to enable both features:

Dictionary

1. Go to **Settings** on your iPad and select **General** on the left hand column.
2. Scroll down to **Keyboard** and then tap on **Keyboards** located in the middle of the screen.
3. Tap **Add New Keyboard...** and select **Spanish**. Use the arrow labeled **Keyboards** at the top of the screen to go back.
4. Tap on **Spanish** and confirm that **QWERTY-Spanish** and **Spanish - ISO** is selected.

Text-to-Speech

1. Go to **Settings** on your iPad and select **General** on the left hand column.
2. Tap on **Accessibility**, then select **Speak Selection**.
3. Tap **Dialects** and scroll down to **Español**. Select **Español (España)** or **Español (Mexico)**.
4. Tap the arrow containing **Speak Selection** at the top of the screen and drag the circle beneath **Speaking Rate** to adjust the speed.
5. (Optional) If you'd like to see what words are being spoken as they are read, tap **Highlight Words**.
6. **To Use:** In any app such as iBooks or Safari, press and hold a selection of Spanish text. Use the blue circle to adjust the selection, then tap **Speak**.
